



Health & Safety:

Riding, working and handling horses can be dangerous, and horses can be unpredictable. Persons using our facilities do so at their own risk.

All riders must wear a hat conforming to current RDA standards whilst mounted and moving around the yard.

Suitable footwear must be worn when mounted and when on the yard.

Care of each rider's personal equipment is the sole responsibility of the rider or their representative.

No medication to be left in unattended bags.

After using the facilities, all equipment is to be put back tidily, in its original place. Droppings are to be removed from the arena and put on the muck heap. This is the responsibility of the session coach.

By using the facilities, riders, their representatives, coaches and volunteers, or personnel responsible, have surveyed the facilities, seen the RDA Group Risk Assessment and are satisfied that the areas being used are safe and suitable.

Be aware that this is a working yard with uneven and muddy / slippery surfaces.

All dogs are contained / restrained when any RDA riders are on site.

No smoking on the yard.

Abingdon RDA will not accept any responsibility for any riders or their family members that are left unsupervised.

All children and student riders must be accompanied by their carers, parents or teachers at all times.

Under no circumstances are any RDA riders, their carers, parents, siblings and teachers to enter into any stables, paddocks, the horse walker or hay barn, unless accompanied by RDA volunteers.

There is to be no feeding of tit-bits to any of the horses or ponies.
