

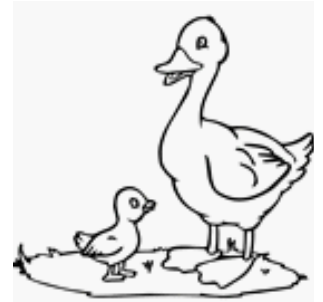
Abingdon RDA Family Coronation Quiz

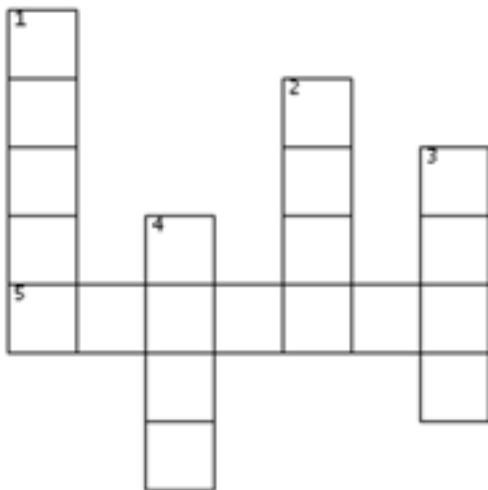
1. Find the word represented by this number code:

- (e) where horses sleep

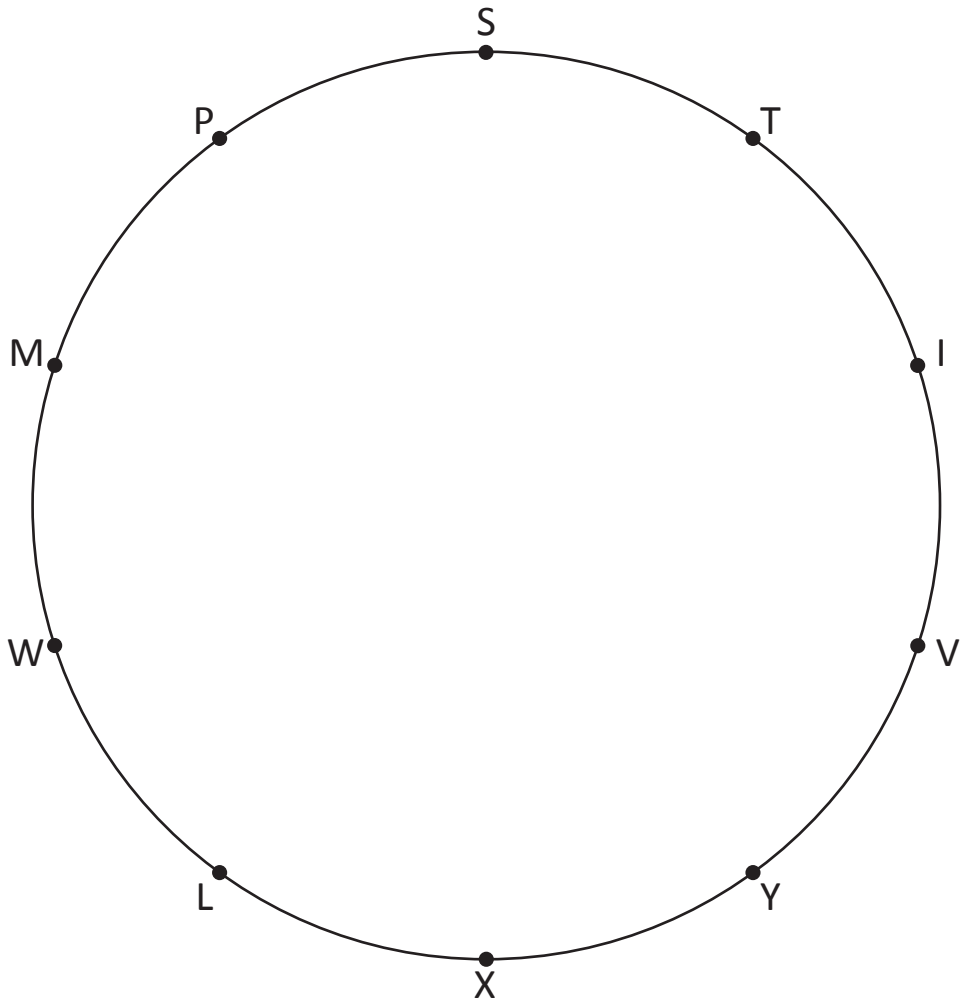
6. Find your way into this maze. Your final word for this clue is in the middle.
